Marilyn,

I am writing this letter in response to Tami Beatty's request for references for the OMEGA Tracer System and OMEGA Carver.

We have had our Omega systems for about 8-9 months now and during this time have developed a great success rate. We are using the T-ring, and the tracing wand for both trans-tibial and trans-femoral applications. Additionally, we have utilized the measurement-based system for some of our trans-femoral patients.

Although there was an initial learning curve I feel it was very reasonable. We now have 3 systems in place in our offices and are in the process of ordering the 4th for our newest office in Meridian, MS. I have also found the portability of the system to be a great asset not only in serving patients in other settings but also as a marketing tool. We do a large number of in-services and routinely take one of our systems for display.

We located the carver in our Jackson office as a central location and although there were some early issues with getting it set up it has proven to work very well for our prosthetic cases. We have just begun trying to utilize our systems for any orthotic work and as yet are not able to carve those models but that is being worked on now.

Over all I must say I am more than pleased. I have had experience with several systems throughout the years including CANFIT, BIOSCULPTOR, and SHAPEMAKER. We actually had a Shapemaker system for several years here. I can say that overall the Omega Tracer system has been the easiest to learn and the most user friendly.
